## **Travel Guidelines**

**Welcome to Cordova!** In the information below you will find specifics on the State of Alaska Health Alert 2 regarding international and interstate travel (State to State) and information on Health Alert 3 regarding intrastate travel (Alaskan community to Alaskan community). Additionally, you will find information on the Alaska Travel Portal. By providing you this and other information in the packet our goal is to prepare you for arrival into Cordova and the successful follow through of local COVID safe measures and community expectations.

### Health Advisory No.2 International and Interstate Travel

The State of Alaska does **NOT REQUIRE COVID-19 testing** for travelers to enter the State of Alaska. Since testing of non-vaccinated travelers is the best means for limiting the spread of COVID-19 virus and variants, it is recommended that non-vaccinated travelers test prior to travel or take advantage of **FREE** and **OPTIONAL COVID-19 testing** available at primary ports of entry in Alaska.

The purpose of this Health Advisory for International and Interstate Travel is to provide clear guidance for non-vaccinated travelers entering Alaska to mitigate the transmission and control the spread of COVID-19 virus.

### I.All international and interstate travelers:

**a.**Read the available information about safely traveling to Alaska. **i.**https://covid19.alaska.gov/fravelers/ii.https://covid19.alaska.gov/faq/

**b.**An **optional** Safe Travels Form can be completed via the Alaska Travel Portal at <a href="https://www.alaska.covidsecureapp.com">www.alaska.covidsecureapp.com</a>. This is the hub for all traveler information and allows travelers to do the following optional items:

i.Request a free SARS-CoV-2 test upon arrival to Alaska.

**ii.**Request a free COVID-19 vaccination upon arrival to Alaska, when they become available at Alaska airports.

iii. Upload viral test results.

- **c.** Any person currently positive with COVID-19, cannot travel to Alaska until they have been released from isolation, or cleared for travel, by a medical provider or public health agency.
- **d.**Please note, some Alaska communities may have local testing and quarantine requirements. Be sure to research the communities you are traveling to.

### **II.Exemptions for Fully Vaccinated Individuals:**

- a. Fully-vaccinated travelers do not need to get tested before or after travel.
- **b.Fully-vaccinated travelers** do not need to self-quarantine after travel.
- **c.Fully vaccinated** is defined as more than two weeks following receipt of the second dose in a two-dose series, or more than two weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine.

### Health Advisory No.3 Intrastate Travel

The State of Alaska **DOES NOT** restrict or limit travel within the state.

**I.Exemptions for Fully Vaccinated Individuals**: State of Alaska and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidance says the following about fully vaccinated travelers:

a. Fully-vaccinated travelers do not need to get tested before or after travel.

b.Fully-vaccinated travelers do not need to self-quarantine after travel.

**c.Fully vaccinated** is defined as more than two weeks following receipt of the second dose in a two-dose series, or more than two weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine.

### II.Prior confirmed positive results within 90 days of departure:

**a.** Asymptomatic travelers, that had a positive viral test for SARS-CoV-2 within 90 days of travel departure, are not recommended to pre-travel test nor test upon arrival.

### **III.Considerations**

**a.**Communities that have enacted or are continuing local ordinances on travel restrictions should take into account the vaccination rates of their residents. COVID-19 vaccines have proven to be highly effective at preventing severe illness and hospitalizations. If your local population has high vaccination rates and are protected, then travel restrictions may not be necessary or useful. Symptomatic persons are not recommended to travel.

**Testing for All Travelers regarding travel into and throughout Alaska into Cordova:** Testing is available at the Anchorage Airport and can be utilized by resident and non-resident travelers. Upon arrival in Cordova our local Ambassadors have a local packet for travelers listing the community testing time that correlates with incoming flights and recommendations listed above.

### Prior confirmed positive results within 90 days of departure – All Travelers:

The traveler does not need to obtain a PCR test, either immediately before travel or upon arrival, if both conditions of the following conditions are met:

- The traveler provides proof of a previously positive result of a PCR test within 90 days of departure.
- The traveler is currently asymptomatic.

Critical Infrastructure Employee Travelers arriving in Alaska from outside the state as part of critical infrastructure workforce traveling specifically for work, as defined in the Cyber and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) "Guidance on the Essential Critical Infrastructure Workforce." <a href="https://www.cisa.gov/publication/guidance-essential-critical-infrastructure-workforce">https://www.cisa.gov/publication/guidance-essential-critical-infrastructure-workforce</a> must arrive with a letter from the employer that identifies the employer and employee by name and details how the employee must travel to their jobsite in accordance with the employers Community Workforce Protection Plan <a href="https://covid19.alaska.gov/unified-command/protective-plans/">https://covid19.alaska.gov/unified-command/protective-plans/</a>. The letter must also confirm the traveler is following the employer's Community Workforce Protection Plan on file with the state of Alaska that includes testing and/or quarantine provisions.

### Cordova Mask Rule

In order to prevent the spread of Covid-19, the City of Cordova issued Emergency Order 2020-008 which states all individuals in Cordova must wear a mask, bandana or other type of cloth protective covering over their nose and mouth when social distancing from another individual of at least six (6) feet is not possible. Facial Coverings need not be worn if:

- You are alone or only with members of your household.
- You are eating or drinking in compliance with State of Alaska health mandates.
- You are receiving services which cannot be performed while wearing a mask; or
- You are under the age of four, have trouble breathing, or have a medical condition which prevents you from wearing a facial covering.

### How do I get vaccinated in Cordova?

### Go to: https://www.cdvcmc.com/ and then click on the link that says COVID-19 Vaccine Sign up Here.

Registration for the vaccine may be done prior to travel into Cordova. If you are scheduling prior to travel leave a comment with your arrival date to assist with potential scheduling. In addition, if you have received your first shot and will need your second, please leave a comment with the date of your first shot and the type of vaccine your received.

CCMC will contact you when we have vaccine available and can schedule an appointment for you. By filling out the vaccination form, you are enhancing our response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The information you provide will be protected pursuant to HIPPA and any other applicable state or federal law.
