

2021 Cordova Chamber Holiday Bazaar COVID-19 Safety Mitigation Plan

- Vendors must wear a mask while setting up, and during the event. We also ask that vendors practice social distancing, to the best of their ability, at all times.
- Vendors will refrain from any demonstration to promote merchandise, that would require physical contact or would cause anyone to lower their mask.
- During vendor set-up vendors will take turns using the elevator to maintain social distancing.
- Vendors will unload their vehicles using staggered arrival times to reduce congestion and close contact.
- Vendor tables are spaced more than 6 feet apart and are limited to no more than 14 vendors to allow ample space for social distancing.
- Signs displaying recommended walking routes through the Bazaar will be visible so patrons can flow through the venue while maintaining social distancing.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be filled, and placed in highly visible spots, on both the upper and lower level of the Atrium.
- All patrons inside the Cordova Center building are required to wear a mask over their mouth and nose per the current CDC and Medical Response Team recommendations.
- Food vendors are expected to focus on take-out/pick-up orders. There is no seating available for patrons to eat at.
- Please monitor your wellness prior to attending this event. We urge you to stay home if you are not feeling well the day/night you have reserved your table/booth or plan to attend the Bazaar.
